# Northeast Florida Scholastic Art Awards

## What is Scholastics?

For 100 years, the Scholastic Art & Writing Awards have recognized the exceptional vision of our nation's youth. Established in 1923 by Scholastic Inc. founder Maurice R. Robinson, the Scholastic Awards have grown to become the nation's highest honor and largest source of scholarships for creative teens. Through a nationwide partner network of more than 100 Affiliates, the 2022 Awards received nearly 400,000 submissions spanning 28 categories of art and writing. Students are encouraged by their educators, both in schools and through out-of-school programs, to submit their original work. All students in grades 7 through 12, whether in public, private, or home schools, can apply.

## What is NEFSAA?

Northeast Florida Scholastic Art Awards (NEFSAA) has been the regional visual art affiliate for the Scholastic Art & Writing Awards for the last 14 years, offering recognition, celebration of, and college scholarship offers for visual art students in our area. NEFSAA handles the regional adjudication, awards, and art exhibitions for six counties including Baker, Clay, Duval, Flagler, Nassau, St. Johns, & Volusia. Gold Key winners at the regional level automatically go on to the national competition.

## NEFSAA and Scholastic Art Awards

The 2022 NEFSAA ceremony was held on February 12<sup>th</sup> at the historic Florida Theatre in downtown Jacksonville, welcoming a record crowd of just over 1800 attendees, and we expect a larger group for 2023's awards ceremony. The award exhibitions were held at the main branch of the Jacksonville Public Library and the downtown Jacksonville University campus, both located on Laura Street in downtown Jacksonville, a short walk from the Florida Theatre.

The 2022 NEFSAA cycle collected 2,810 student submissions from 1006 students. 1,452 awards were distributed to 608 student winners. These regional award winners earned college scholarship offers from SCAD, UNF, and JU, as well as cash prizes. Of the 385 students awarded regional Gold Keys, 34 went on to earn awards at the national level. This was a record year in many ways and we look forward to what will happen in 2023!
